The DWC Assistance Fund Request Application provides the necessary form for the requesting applicant/recipient. The information provided in the application is treated with utmost and strictest confidence. The DWC responds to all those requesting assistance with utmost respect.

Some examples of assistance provided can include grocery store or department store gift certificates and/or cards, and full or partial payment of rent, utilities, or child care. The DWC Assistance Fund can also help provide food during such Holidays as Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas to the needy in conjunction with other local charities.

All request applications are reviewed by the DWC Executive Board. Careful thought and consideration goes into every decision. It is important to note that DWC is a small non-profit organization comprised of all volunteer women. So decisions to provide assistance are based on available funds and each individual situation of the applicant. The DWC Executive Board strives to respond to all requests in a timely manner.
